

**RESOLUTION TO APPROVE AN INCREASE IN FEE FOR THE
SCHOOL OF MANAGEMENT EMBA PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the costs associated with providing the instruction and related activities including textbooks, food, and the foreign study and Washington tours for the Executive MBA Program have increased; and

WHEREAS, the student fee for this program has not been increased for several years; and

WHEREAS, to effectively market the Program for the coming year, it is recommended that the increase be approved at this time, to be effective with the Fall 2010 semester; and

WHEREAS, compared to other AACSB accredited competitor schools in Northern and Central New Jersey who offer EMBA programs, NJIT charges the lowest fee; and

WHEREAS, the administration recommends this increased fee.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees approves the increase in the Program Fee for the EMBA program from \$47,500 to \$57,000 effective with the commencement of the Fall 2010 semester.
