



MASTER'S FELLOWSHIP

The Master's Fellowship provides a \$2,000 tuition award each semester to qualified students who are admitted for full-time graduate study within an initial master's degree program at New Jersey Institute of Technology. To be considered for the fellowship, master's applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Completion of an earned baccalaureate degree from an accredited college or university,
- Achievement of an undergraduate cumulative GPA of at least 3.0 (or its equivalent)
- Submission of GRE/GMAT (international applicants only)

The Master's Fellowship is renewable for a maximum of three consecutive semesters of full-time study (four semesters for students enrolled in the MBA program; six semesters for students enrolled in the Master of Architecture program) in a student's initial graduate program at NJIT. Students receiving the fellowship must maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.25 or better, and make satisfactory progress toward a degree during enrollment at NJIT. Academic records will be reviewed at the conclusion of each semester to determine a student's eligibility for the subsequent semester. Students who wish to pursue a second master's degree at NJIT and applicants for doctoral study are not eligible for this award.

The Office of Graduate Admissions will review all admitted students who satisfy the criteria and make recommendations to the Office of Graduate Studies. Recipients of the fellowship will be notified in writing. No special application is required.
