

## Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship



New Jersey Institute of Technology awards five Phi Theta Kappa Scholarships to full-time transfer students. The Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship is a full tuition scholarship (\$8592 a year in 2005-2006). Scholarship recipients are expected to maintain a grade point average of 3.0 (B) or better. Academic records will be reviewed at the conclusion of each semester.

### Scholarship Qualifications

- Completion of A.A.S. degree before beginning studies at NJIT
- Cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher
- U.S. citizen or permanent resident
- Submission of a letter of recommendation from your Phi Theta Kappa Honor Society Advisor

### Application

There is no special application form required. Students must complete and submit an application for admission to NJIT along with the non-refundable application fee. All qualified applicants will be notified by mail. The application deadline is July 1.
