
To help in your identification of potential nominees, please consider these factors:

- The endeavor(s) need not have brought public acclaim, but may consist of important creative efforts; contributions to social, educational or technological progress; distinguished leadership in the person's chosen profession, industry or public service.
- Service to the university is not mandatory, but is desirable.

The selection of these new 2011 honorees will be made shortly after the January 28th submission deadline. At that time, we will publicly announce the honorees and provide information about the Saturday, May 21, 2011 event at which the new Alumni Achievement Honor Roll members will be celebrated.
