

Spring 2019 Agreement of Registration and Financial Obligation

By registering for classes at NJIT:

- 1. I promise to pay all assessed tuition and fees as a result of this registration, unless I cancel prior to the first day of the term.
- 2. If I do not cancel my classes before the beginning of the term I understand that I will be held responsible for paying all or some portion of tuition and fees based on my date of withdrawal.
- 3. I also promise to pay any additional charges I incur, including, but not limited to, charges for room, board, parking, class materials, and other departmental or college charges.
- 4. I understand that if my account goes into collections for non-payment, I am responsible for all collection costs and fees, and I am subject to credit bureau reporting.

Financial Obligations

- 1. I understand that the University is advancing value to me in the form of educational services and that my right to register is expressly conditioned upon my agreement to pay the costs of tuition and fees and any additional costs when those charges become due.
- 2. I understand that, regardless of my eligibility for financial aid, I am personally responsible for the full amount assessed to me as a result of my registration and attendance.
