FS motion to adopt a joint chair structure for the CUE and CGE As approved by Faculty Senate September 14, 2017

As per the Bylaws of the Faculty Senate, membership in the Faculty Senate standing committee on Graduate Education (CGE) requires voting members to consist of one member of the Graduate Faculty from each academic unit and the Associate Provost for Graduate Studies to serve as the committee chair; membership in the Faculty Senate standing committee on Undergraduate Education requires voting members to consist of one representative from each academic unit; the Associate Provost for Academic Affairs and one representative from the Albert Dorman Honors College.

In recognition of each committee's broad, often multifaceted purview and set of charges, requiring the expertise, advice, and subsequent recommendations of both faculty and the university administration, the Faculty Senate has moved to adopt a joint chair structure for both the CUE and CGE consisting of one member from the Provost's Office and one member from Faculty. The standing Committee on Graduate Education (CGE) will require the Associate Provost for Graduate Studies to serve as the committee chair jointly with a co-chair elected from committee voting members of the Graduate Faculty; the standing Committee on Undergraduate Education (CUE) will require one voting representative from one academic unit to serve as committee chair jointly with the Vice Provost for Undergraduate Education as co-chair.
