

April 2019 CUE Report

Curriculum Updates

1. New GER courses: HIST 320, PHIL 310, STS 315, STS 383, and STS 384 satisfy the History and Humanities GER (300+ Level).
2. GER Subcommittee Regarding Additional GER Literacies

The committee did not act on the directive from the Faculty Senate regarding the expansion of the categories for GER literacies, specifically in Engineering, Architecture, and Biology. The consensus was that the GER committee cannot act before a written proposal is presented from the relevant unit regarding the content and purpose of the new GER literacy. Moreover, given the new state requirements for 120 credit undergraduate degree programs, there was little interest among the committee members to re-open and expand the GER at the present time.
