

Master Promissory Note (MPN) for Direct PLUS Loans

One of the requirements in receiving a Direct PLUS (Parent Loan for Undergraduate Students) loan is that *your parent* complete a Master Promissory Note (MPN). The MPN explains the terms and conditions of the loan and is a legally binding agreement to repay the loan to the U.S. Department of Education.

In order to complete the MPN, your parent must have a U.S. Department of Education Personal Identification Number (PIN), which can be applied for at <http://www.pin.ed.gov>.
