Eligibility: Must be a current NJIT student.

Deadline for submissions: October 31, 2017

Entries: May submit up to two (2) entries.

Photo Requirements: Submissions must be a high-resolution JPEG file. The minimum image resolution needed is 3600 x 2400 pixels.

Submission: Email your photo to <u>global@njit.edu</u> with the subject line "PHOTO CONTEST". Submissions must include the student's name, ID number, and a sentence indicating the location and subject of the photo. Winners will be contacted by email and their names and photos will be displayed on the OGI's website.

Criteria: Photos may provide a sense of the local culture, people, customs and traditions. They can also include architecture, scenery or landmarks, or photos of learning and academic experiences in an international context. We welcome photos that show NJIT Highlander pride.

Voting and Prizes: All selected photos will be printed and displayed in the Campus Center Gallery on Thursday, November 16, during International Education Week (Nov. 13 – 17). The NJIT community will have a chance to vote and select the best photos. Exciting prizes for the winners!
