Vision for NJIT

- Build from strategic plan developed for Middle States
 - A crisp and focused plan
 - Measurable goals
 - Maintain a “scorecard”
 - Allocate resources consistent with goals
- Educational program quality
 - Serve diverse student population
 - Ensure research program that works well with undergraduate and graduate programs
 - Provide a solid basis to continue to move up in the rankings



- Grow research capacity in a focused way
 - Large-scale, mostly interdisciplinary efforts
 - Build on strengths or opportunities
 - Meet local, state and regional needs
 - Partnerships with industry to impact the economy
 - e.g., **Nanotechnology consortium**
- Impact the local and regional economy
 - Intellectual property commercialization
 - **Aggressive incentive for commercialization**
 - Science Park incubator
 - Revenue stream for NJIT



- Further develop a sense of community
 - Bring back alumni
 - Foster new friends
 - Executive Director of the Alumni Association to report to Vice President for Advancement
- Grow endowment levels
 - Enhance NJIT
 - Enhance rather than replace
 - Support for students and faculty
