STUDENT LIVING

Over 1400 students live on campus in four co-ed residence halls. More than 50 percent of first year students live on campus. Rooms are fully furnished, air-conditioned and wired for networking to the University's main computer system and to the Internet. Each hall has common area and facilities including:

- Lounges
- Study Areas
- Kitchens
- Laundry Rooms
- Game Room

Rooms are wired for cable TV, including HBO. Other services include: Washers and Dryers, Snack and Soda Machines, Recreational Equipment (ping-pong, pool, large screen televisions, etc.) and Mail Service (Mon-Fri).

First year students live in Cypress and Redwood Halls. Upper class students can live in every building, but often choose to live in Laurel or Oak halls.

LIVING LEARNING COMMUNITIES

Living Learning Communities provide an environment that can enhance motivation to learn, stimulate learning in specific areas of interest and offers opportunities to work closely with staff and faculty members. Current Living Learning Communities include: Architecture, Biomedical Engineering/Biology, Electrical and Computer Engineering, First Year Connections and Honors. Each semester, each Learning Community creates and plans events that provide focus including creating study groups, sharing their own work(s) or attending or participating in events in the campus and local community.

HOW DO I APPLY FOR HOUSING?

Once you have been admitted to NJIT, you can complete the online Housing Application and Contract. It is located on our website: www.njit.edu/reslife. Submit a one-time \$50 non-refundable housing deposit (credit card, check or money order payable to NJIT). Our address is below for mailing a check or money order.

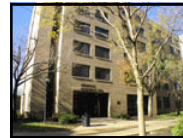
Applications/deposits for first year student received by May 1 are guaranteed housing. After May 1, housing is assigned based on the distance you live from campus, need and date of application. You will receive confirmation in your NJIT email immediately after you submit your application online.

REDWOOD HALL

Approximately 209 first year and upper class students in double and triple rooms. Residents share two (gender specific) community bathrooms on each floor.

CYPRESS HALL

Suite-style building with approximately 430 first year and upper class students in double and triple rooms. Suites are comprised of two bedrooms and a shared bathroom and foyer.

LAUREL HALL

Suite-style building with approximately 582 upper class students in single and double rooms. Suites have a shared bathroom and foyer.

OAK HALL

Approximately 180 upper class and graduate students housed in both suite-style rooms and apartments. Each suite-style room has a kitchenette and shared bathrooms. Each apartment has a kitchen, living room and bathroom. Suites are comprised of two double rooms. Apartment set ups include: a single with a double bedroom, two double bedrooms or a double with a three person room.

COST OF LIVING ON CAMPUS

The cost to live in a double room on campus in Cypress, Laurel and Oak is \$3,445* per person/per semester and Redwood Hall is \$3,250* per person/per semester.

The Residence Life housing contract includes the fall semester, winter break and the spring semester. Students do not pay an additional amount for housing during the winter break, it is included in the current room rate. Summer housing is an additional cost. Twelve month housing contracts are available for an additional charge per semester. The 12-month contract ends on July 31, if the student is not returning for the following fall semester.

These are rates for the fall 2009-spring 2010. Rates increase each academic year from 3-7%.

WHAT ARE THE MEAL PLAN OPTIONS?

Freshman and sophomores are required to purchase a meal plan and are required to select from plans A – E. Meal Plans are subject to change. The amount will be encoded onto your student ID card. Choose one of the following meal plans:

- A Plan – Unlimited, Continuous Dining, 5 Guest entries per semester - \$1458
- B Plan – Unlimited, Continuous Dining, 5 Guest entries per semester, 100 flex points - \$1563
- C Plan – Unlimited, Continuous Dining, 5 Guest entries per semester, 200 flex points - \$1668
- D Plan – Unlimited, Continuous Dining, 5 Guest entries per semester, 300 flex points - \$1773
- E Plan – Unlimited, Continuous Dining, 5 Guest entries per semester, 600 flex points - \$2088
- F Plan – 3 anytime entries per week, 5 Guest entries per semester, 400 flex points - \$1038
- G Plan – 1047 flex points (\$300 fixed expenses) - \$1414
- H Plan – 80 anytime entries per semester, 5 guest entries per semester - \$723

*These are the rates for 2009-10 academic year.

WHERE CAN I USE MY FLEX DOLLARS?

Flex dollars can be used in the: NJ Express C-Store (convenience items, grab and go sandwiches and salads, bottled beverages, snacks and frozen meals), Dining Room (to purchase all you can eat meals), Highlander Club (offers quick, fast food options from the grill), Leafs (offers salads), Grains (wraps, sandwiches, etc.), Tech Café (offers gourmet coffee, assorted pastries and panini sandwiches), Ice Cream Shop (offers cones, sundaes, etc.), Brick Oven Pizza and Taco Bell (Tex Mex, Value Meals).

CAMPUS SAFETY

NJIT students use electronic cards for access to residence halls. Desk attendants are on duty 24 hours a day and provide security for the residence halls by monitoring hall entrances and swiping resident IDs. All guests must have a valid photo ID and must be signed into the residence hall by a resident host. Guests must be accompanied by their hosts at all times. Residence Life has staff on-duty in each hall during non-business hours. In addition, NJIT's Public Safety Officers patrol campus 24 hours a day. Patrols are conducted on foot, in cars, motor scooters and bicycles. Rooftop surveillance cameras are mounted throughout campus and monitored around the clock.
