- **Student Honors:** The new programs build on decades of NJSOA leadership in computer-assisted design, as demonstrated by the national awards and recognition garnered by students. The most recent honor went to NJSOA student Dave Rittinger, selected by *Surface* to be featured in its annual guide to outstanding undergraduate and graduate design for his “Jersey City Bridge Museum” designed in Assistant Professor Richard Garber’s studio.
- **MOMA Project:** The school’s FABLAB offers unique support to design students with cutting edge computer numerically controlled (CNC) 3D prototyping equipment. Architecture students had the opportunity to participate in NJIT’s contribution to an exhibition of the Burst House, designed by NJSOA adjunct **Douglas Gauthier**, at the Museum of Modern Art in New York City. Through the FABLAB, students helped to build one of five prefabricated homes erected in the outdoor space next to the museum.
- **Digital Archive:** NJSOA became the first school in the nation to store all student work electronically with its custom-designed, web-based Kepler Information System. The digital archiving system is expected to become the new standard for recording and retrieving student work at schools nationally.
