



- 1 **NJIT:** The 45-acre campus is convenient to everything.
- 2 **BEARS AND EAGLES RIVERFRONT STADIUM:** This 6,200-seat stadium, opened in 1999, is home to the Bears minor league baseball team and NJIT Highlander baseball.
- 3 **COLLEGE WALK:** Walk this safe, well-lit path to downtown.
- 4 **ESSEX COUNTY COLLEGE:** More than 25,000 people enroll in classes each year at the 22-acre campus.
- 5 **MILITARY PARK:** Cool statues and farmer's market through October.
- 6 **NEWARK MUSEUM:** 80 galleries of art and science, plus a planetarium.
- 7 **NEWARK PUBLIC LIBRARY:** NJ's largest public library and an architectural gem.
- 8 **NEW JERSEY PERFORMING ARTS CENTER:** 12-acre site with 2,750-seat and 500-seat theatres features internationally known music, dance and theatre.

- 9 **PENN STATION:** Amtrak, NJ Transit, PATH and subway trains offer easy access to New York City.
- 10 **RUTGERS-NEWARK:** Cross-register at the 37-acre campus of 10,000 students; also home to an important jazz collection.
- 11 **SETON HALL LAW SCHOOL:** Nearly 1,500 students pursue law degrees here.
- 12 **UMDNJ:** Specializes in the health sciences; includes medical and dental schools enrolling 2,300 students.
- 13 **UNIVERSITY HEIGHTS SCIENCE PARK:** NJIT is taking the lead in developing these 50 acres and 1 million square feet of high-tech start-ups and labs.
- 14 **UNIVERSITY HOSPITAL:** The teaching hospital of UMDNJ.
- 15 **PRUDENTIAL CENTER:** The newly opened sports and entertainment arena has more than 17,000 seats.
