NJIT Salary Report of May 2017 Graduates

The class of 2017 continued to fill the pipeline that has earned NJIT top spots in the U.S. for students' return on their tuition investment. The combined average starting salary for all NJIT BS/BA graduates of \$61,700 continues to exceed those of all 2017 U.S. graduates by 22%. NJIT graduates on average earn starting salaries that are \$11,000 more than BS graduates nationwide.
