You must submit documentation of your high school completion or an equivalent along with this form. If you provided documentation last year, please check the last box below and just submit this form. Please check the high school completion document you are attaching to this worksheet.

- A copy of a High School Diploma.
- A copy of a final, official high school transcript that shows the date when the high school diploma was awarded.
- If you completed secondary education in a foreign country, a copy of the “secondary school leaving certificate” or other similar document.
- A copy of a General Educational Development (GED) certificate or GED transcript that indicates the student passed the exam.
- A state certificate or transcript you received after you passed a State-authorized examination such as the High School Equivalency Test or the Test Assessing Secondary Completion that the State recognizes as the equivalent of a high school diploma. Test transcripts are acceptable documentation if they indicate that the final score is a passing score or that the student’s state considers the test results to meet its high school equivalency requirements.
- An academic transcript that indicates you successfully completed at least a two-year program that is acceptable for full credit toward a bachelor’s degree.
- If you were homeschooled in a state where state law requires a student to obtain a secondary school completion credential for homeschool (other than a high school diploma or its recognized equivalent), a copy of that credential.
- If you were homeschooled in a state where state law does not require a student to obtain a secondary school completion credential for homeschool (other than a high school diploma or its recognized equivalent), a transcript or the equivalent, signed by your parent or guardian, that lists the secondary school courses you completed and includes a statement that you successfully completed a secondary school education in a homeschool setting.
- Documentation of High School Diploma or equivalent was provided to the financial aid office last year.
