



***Student Financial Aid Services (SFAS)***

***Financial Aid Request - Winter Session***

Students must be registered for a Winter course at NJIT and working toward a degree at NJIT to request Winter Session aid; additionally, students must:

- Have filed a 2018–2019 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) ([www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov));
- Return all requested financial aid documents to *Student Financial Aid Services (SFAS)* by their respective deadlines;
- Meet the minimum standards set forth in the university [Satisfactory Academic Progress \(SAP\) policy](#). (The exception is certain private loans; please see website under *Private Loans* below);
- Submit Winter Aid Application to SFAS by December 14, 2018.

**Federal Pell Grant (available to undergraduates only)**

If you were a part-time student during the Fall 2018 semester and were eligible for a Federal Pell Grant, you may have remaining grant eligibility for the Winter Session. You are automatically considered for a Federal Pell Grant if you have remaining eligibility for winter by returning this form.

**NJ Tuition Aid Grant/EOF (available to undergraduates only)**

If you were a part-time student during the Fall 2018 semester (registered for at least nine credits) and are TAG/EOF eligible you will automatically be considered for TAG/EOF by returning this form.

**NJIT Winter Grant (available to undergraduates only)**

NJIT has very limited grant funding to support students in financing the cost of the Winter Session. Funds are awarded based on financial need, total number of applicants, and available funding.

**Federal Loans (if Fall 2018 loan allocation is not exhausted)**
