## YOUR EDUCATION COULD BE EVEN MORE AFFORDABLE WITH FINANCIAL AID

The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA®) allows students to apply for financial aid to help pay for college. The U.S. Department of Education and the states use this form to determine a student's eligibility for need-based aid like federal and state grants. Other types of aid such as scholarships, loans, and work-study also require the completion of a FAFSA. We encourage you to submit your FAFSA as soon as possible to maximize your aid eligibility as this is the single most important step you can take to make college more affordable.

The 2023-2024 FAFSA is now available. We are offering workshops to help you complete the FAFSA. Please register for a workshop that best suits your schedule. Kindly ensure the required documents are ready before you come to the workshop.

## WHAT YOU MUST BRING

- FSA ID (student and parent of a dependent student). [Create FSA ID](#) before the workshop.
- Social Security Number for student.
- Social Security Number for the parent of a dependent student (age 23 or younger).
- Student's Alien Registration Number (if not a U.S. citizen).
- Student's Driver's License Number/State ID Number (if you have one).
- 2021 Federal tax return (1040), including W-2 information for you (and your spouse, if you are married).
- 2021 Federal tax return (1040), including W-2 information for your parents if you are a dependent student.
- 2021 foreign tax return (if applicable).
- Records of untaxed income, such as child support received, interest income, and veteran's non-education benefits, for you and for your parents if you are a dependent student.
- Information on cash, savings, and checking account balances; investments, including stocks and bonds and real estate, but not including the home in which you live; and business and farm assets for you and your parents if you are a dependent student.
