

The Office of Student Financial Aid Services is delighted to share the news that funding for “Year-Round Pell” is available for summer 2022! This means that students can receive an additional Pell Grant award during the summer term; the amount of the summer Pell award will depend on the number of credits taken during the summer, however the Pell award will not cover your entire tuition and fee balance. The additional Pell award will allow you to stay on track towards graduation or even to complete your undergraduate degree early.

Eligibility Criteria for the Additional Pell Grant are the Following:

- Received 100% of Pell award used during the 2021-2022 academic year;
- Summer enrollment of at least 6 credits (for summer this can be 3 credits in the full, first, or middle session and 3 credits in second session);
- Pass the standards of Satisfactory Academic Progress (annual assessment occurs after Spring grades are posted).
