



Grants Management Software System Implementation

In the past six months, during the go-live implementation phase of the Grant Management System - Streamlyne, there has been a series of research administration initiatives aimed at reforming the different steps of the award cycle. The first implementation module – Proposal submission has been increasingly showing the needs for policies and procedures in place to improve grant administration.

In addition to the implementation of the Grants Management System, the Research Office (RO) continues to oversee the ongoing federal reforms initiatives. These initiatives include consolidating and revising grants management circulars, simplifying the pre-award phase, promoting shared information technology (IT), and

improving the timeliness of grant close out.

Today we have successfully submitted about 181 proposals. This represents about 55% of the total proposals submitted during this current Fiscal Year – FY17. The following table shows the data by college:
