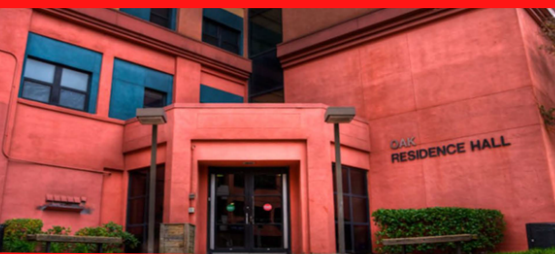

SELECTION TIMELINE

June 6th, 2022 - June 13th, 2022

Check your priority number (the date/time you will be able to select your room online).

- Login to Self Service here:
https://njit.datacenter.adirondacksolutions.com/njit_thdss_prod/index.html
- On your Home page, you will see 'Room Selection'. You will see your Start time and your priority number. This is the date and time you will be selecting your room online.
- Below your Priority Number, you will see 'Selection Times'. This is the time period that the entire process will occur. Your start time will fall somewhere between one of the selection times listed.

Selecting Roommates(s) and/or Suitemate(s)

- Login to Self Service here:
https://njit.datacenter.adirondacksolutions.com/njit_thdss_prod/index.html
- On your Home page, select 'Room Selection' then select 'Roommates' (this includes suitemates).
- Select 'Fall 2022' term.
- Select 'Search for Roommate'.
- Enter the last and/or first name of the student(s) you would like to live with.
- Select and add the student. Each student in your room/suitemate group will need to select and match with everyone in your group. The student with the best priority time will select the space for everyone in your group.

SELECTION TIMELINE

June 17th, 2022

Honors Hall Room Assignments

- Placement in the Honors Hall is based on the date you submitted your application and admission to the Honors College.
- Residence Life staff will place you into your room assignment. You **DO NOT** participate in Open Room Selection.
- Honors students not able to be placed into the Honors Hall due to limited space will be assigned to a room in Cypress Hall.
- If you found a roommate online through RoomSync, you may update this information on your housing application online through the Self Service portal. **You have until June 13, 2022 to add this information.**

June 22nd, 2022 – June 29th, 2022

Open Room Selection

- "Based on the date you submitted your application you will be given a priority number. Your priority number will tell you the date and time you will log in to select a room in either Cypress or Redwood Halls.
- You will add your roommate/suitemate preferences as indicated above prior to selecting a room online.
Remember that each member in your group must match in order to be placed together by the student with the best priority number

CONTRACT HIGHLIGHTS

It is your responsibility to READ and REVIEW the housing application and contract VERY CAREFULLY. When you sign the contract, you are agreeing to all of its terms and conditions. Please note, this room selection guide does not cover all of the terms and conditions of the housing application and contract.

<p>ACADEMIC- YEAR CONTRACT (9-MONTH)</p>	<p>The university shall provide the resident with the use of a residence hall space for one academic-year or balance remaining at the time of assignment. <u>This period does NOT include summer break.</u> The contract period commences on the day before the start of fall classes and ends on the last day of exams at the end of the semester or 24 hours after a resident's last exam, whichever is earlier.</p>
<p>TWELVE-MONTH CONTRACT</p>	<p>The university shall provide the resident with the use of a residence hall space 24 hours before classes for the student's specific school or program year begins and ends on <u>July 31, 2022</u> for students not returning to housing for the next year. Students returning to housing for the 2022-2023 academic-year may remain in housing through the beginning of the new contract period. <u>Changes to the chosen occupancy period may not be made after October 31, 2022.</u> Residents may be required to move to another location during the summer break.</p>
<p>ALL CONTRACTS</p>	<p>Written notification from the university to a resident of their removal and prohibition from university Housing may also terminate the contract.</p> <p>In consideration of either the academic-year or twelve-month housing assignment, the resident agrees to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pay the residence hall room charge for an entire contract. • Purchase a meal plan (except junior, senior and graduate students).

CONTRACT HIGHLIGHTS

CONSOLIDATION

Residence Life reserves the right to move a resident from one room to another when the university determines that the move is in the resident's best interest or those of his/her fellow students and/or the university.

PAYMENT AND CANCELLATION

The contract period begins on published move-in day or actual occupancy, whichever is earlier. After this date, cancellations are not permitted for any NJIT enrolled student without approval of Housing Cancellations Appeal Committee. Cancellations must be in writing. Make sure to read the full terms and conditions, specifically the cancellation policy as outlined in this document www.njit.edu/reslife.

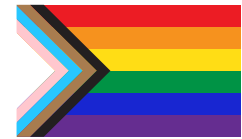

SPECIAL COMMUNITIES

<p>GENDER INCLUSIVE</p>	<p>Gender Inclusive housing refers to a housing option in which two or more students mutually agree to share a multiple-occupancy bedroom, suite, or apartment without regard to the gender of the occupants. Interested students will select the Gender Inclusive housing option when they apply for housing and indicate the name of the student(s) they would like to live with. Residence Life will assign the students to a room/suite based on the request and email the students the room assignment information.</p>
<p>LGBTQA+</p>	<p>We offer students an opportunity to be matched to live with a roommate who identifies as lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer/questioning, or an ally (LGBTQA). An ally is defined as someone who identifies as straight and wants to be supportive of those who identify as LGBTQ. Interested students will select the LGBTQA option when they apply for housing. Residence Life will pair up students based on class year, roommate requests and/or community type requests. Students will be notified of their room assignments via email.</p>
<p>MODEST LIFESTYLE</p>	<p>Modest lifestyle housing features a no-visitation policy by members of the opposite sex, a commitment to a 24 hour quiet lifestyle as well as a commitment to an alcohol and smoke free lifestyle. Interested students will select Modest Lifestyle housing option when they apply for housing and indicate the name of the student(s) they would like to live with. Residence Life will assign the students to a room/suite based on the request and email the students the room assignment information.</p>
<p>GRADUATE & 23+</p>	<p>The 8th floor of Oak Hall will house only graduate students or students who will be 23 years of age or older by September 1, 2022. Undergraduates who will be 21 or 22 years of age on September 1, 2022 may request to be placed on a wait list for available space that may be available after August 15, 2022.</p>



SPECIAL COMMUNITIES

<p>THE VILLAGE</p>	<p>The Village also known as Greek Village, consists of 10 houses, with nine under Residence Life and one privately owned. Starting fall 2022, this housing option is exclusively for members of NJIT recognized social Greek Letter Organizations. It allows members of the same organization to live together, hosts events and programs. This area is supported by both Residence Life and Fraternity and Sorority Life (FSL).</p>
<p>ARCHITECTURE & DESIGN</p>	<p>First-year students who belong to the Hillier College of Architecture and Design (CoAD) can choose to live with each other on the fourth floor of Cypress Hall. Being that the CoAD major courses are unlike any other at NJIT, it creates a great opportunity for support and community as the student navigates their first year of studio.</p>
<p>ENGINEERING</p>	<p>The fifth floor of Cypress houses the Engineering floor. This is another opportunity for networking in support as first-year students navigate some common core courses and decide upon their major within the Newark College of Engineering (NCE).</p>
<p>HONORS COLLEGE LLC</p>	<p>Members of the Honors College can opt into living in the Albert Dorman Honors Residence Hall which is solely for Honors College. Students can take advantage of the many resources such as the computer labs, library, classrooms, and the Honors College administrative offices which are located in the building. First-year students also take first year seminar together.</p>
<p>ENTREPRENEURSHIP (NEW LLC)</p>	<p>In connection with VentureLink, a small cohort of residents will receive mentorship and networking from industry professionals. This LLC is located in Maple Hall.</p>
<p>FORENSIC SCIENCE (NEW LLC)</p>	<p>A small cohort of residential students in the forensic science program with receive mentorship and participate in programming, experience faculty speakers and more!</p>

A suite-style building with approximately 420 first-year and upper-class students living in single, and double rooms. Suites include two bedrooms, a shared bathroom and foyer.

Did you know that Redwood was the first hall that opened at NJIT in 1979?

Renovated in 2015, Redwood is a 195 first-year and upper-class students residence hall. In this hall residents will be living in singles and doubles.

Redwood is a more traditional style residence hall with two (gender-specific) community bathrooms on each floor.

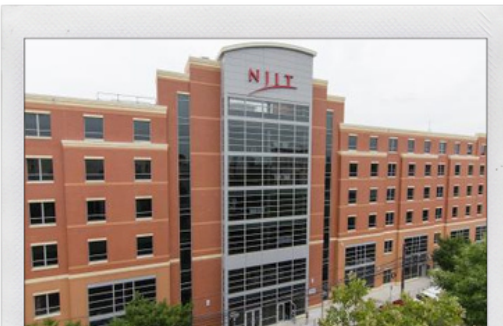


Redwood

Opened in 2013, this hall houses 360 honors students and is home to the Albert Dorman Honors College, convenience store, Smash Burger, and fitness center.

RESIDENCE LIFE STAFF

Each semester, our staff host many events to get residents out of their rooms to interact, and build life-long friendships! These programs are hosted by Resident Assistants, and fellow residents in hall council and Residence Hall Association (RHA). Each hall has a professional staff member living in the residence hall for added support and are readily available to assist you.

Each hall has an office that has the following staff:

- Coordinator/Assistant Director (GV) – runs the building
- Office Assistant – admin for the hall office
- Resident Assistants – live on the floors and are a resource for residents / do programming and crisis response
- Central Office Staff – this office consists of Admin, Associate Directors and the Director of Residence Life. They oversee the day-to-day operations of the department and provides additional support to each hall as needed.

MEAL PLANS

<p>MEAL PLAN & COST</p> 	<p>A meal plan provides a cost-effective, convenient way for students to enjoy campus dining. Each meal plan comes with Meal Swipes. Some also come with guest swipes and the opportunity to load dining dollars onto your ID.</p>
<p>MEAL SWIPES</p> 	<p>A meal swipe is an easy way to get a meal. You are allowed one meal swipe for each meal period: breakfast, lunch, and dinner unless you have plan J; see the next page for details.</p>
<p>DINING DOLLARS</p> 	<p>Dining dollars work just like cash. They can be used at any campus dining location, any time. If you need a quick snack or beverage any of the many on-campus eateries, dining dollars are the go-to option.</p>
<p>ROLLOVER POLICY</p> 	<p>Dining Dollars do rollover from the Fall to Spring semesters. Unused meal swipes do not rollover from semester to semester. Dining dollars expire at the end of the academic year.</p>
<p>OTHER GUIDELINES</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - First and second year students (by credit hour) living on campus must purchase a meal plan as part of their contract. They can select from plans A - E. - Rates are per semester - The rates advertised are for each semester during the 2021-2022 academic year - Dining locations and options are subject to change
