2018 Southeast Brownfields Conference



NJIT TAB participated in the 2018 Southeast Brownfields Conference in Birmingham, Alabama. The event was hosted by the Alabama Brownfields Association in partnership USEPA Region 4 and the Alabama Department of Environmental Management (ADEM).

The 2-day event was held on September 26 and 27, 2018. The conference drew approximately 250 attendees from federal, state, and local governments (including EPA); community groups; higher education; professional organizations; and laboratories, as well as attorneys, developers, and contractors.

The event included a mobile workshop at the Sloss Furnace Site (pictured) and a variety of sessions.



NJIT TAB developed and presented two sessions at the workshop: "Gentrification and Brownfields: How do we usher in revitalization without pushing people out?" and "Tapping into TAB: Free Assistance to Brownfield Communities".
