NJIT TAB All-EPA Brownfield Grantee Meetings are one-day seminars that focus on the issues that are relevant to EPA grantees in a particular state. Typically these sessions include an update on hot topics from USEPA and the respective state environmental agency. Agenda topics have included financial literacy and awareness, grant opportunities and other financial and technical resources, lessons learned from grantees, climate change and resiliency, brownfield redevelopment from a developer's perspective, clean energy, brownfield redevelopment in floodplains, as well as land-use charrettes and community visioning.

All-EPA Brownfield Grantee Meetings provide a platform for peer to peer exchange of knowledge. In addition, the communities that participate in these meetings benefit from an increased knowledge of



grant requirements, regulatory changes and various federal and state programs, and solutions for issues relating to green and sustainable reuse of brownfield sites.
