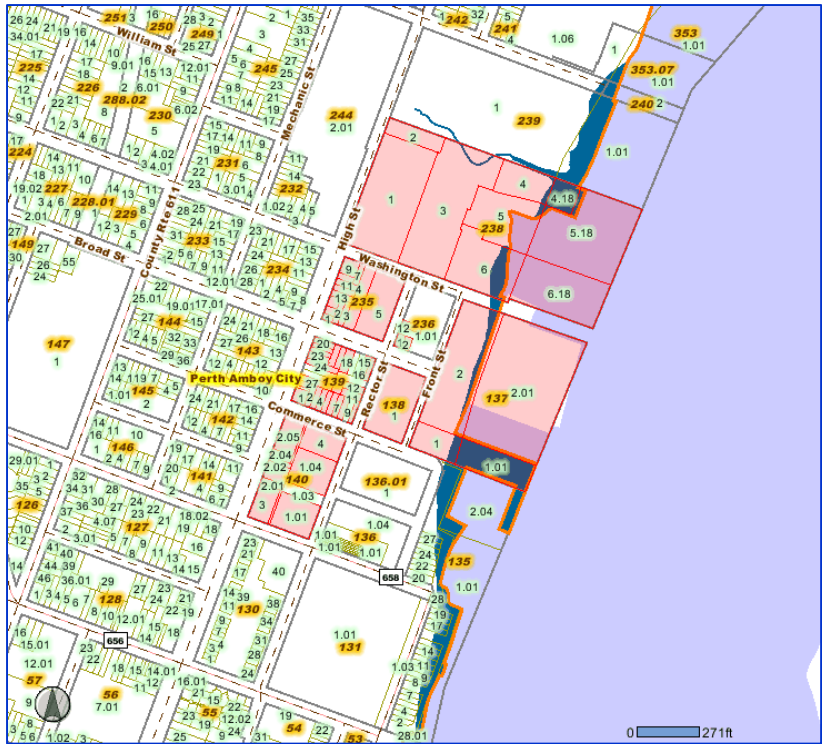


Direct Technical Mentoring

The MCIA received a Community Wide Assessment grant targeted for the Cities of Woodbridge and Perth Amboy. NJIT TAB assisted MCIA with the consultant selection process by reviewing the proposals submitted by consultants in response to MCIA's RFP. That review included an analysis of the technical programs proposed by each consultant as well as the cost implications. NJIT TAB also reviewed the project information for the Arthur Kill Area properties and prepared an environmental summary and mapping of sites located within the City of Perth Amboy. For each of these mapped sites NJIT TAB requested a file review at the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection to obtain the status of each site. In addition, NJIT TAB identified potential funding sources for the next phase of cleanup and redevelopment. The data obtained in the file searches and related potential funding sources were compiled in a findings report and submitted to MCIA.
