NJIT TAB Provides Much Needed Resources to Fitzwilliam, NH

At the request of the Town of Fitzwilliam, New Hampshire, NJIT TAB conducted a Brownfields **Basics** Workshop October 7, 2019 in Fitzwilliam at the Fitzwilliam Town Hall. N.JIT designed the workshop in response to Fitzwilliam's needs and conducted it **EPA** Region along side 1. New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services, and the Region **Planning** Southwest Commission, NJIT TAB served as an expert speaker on navigating brownfield redevelopment process and dispelling persistent brownfield myths that inhibit forward movement projects. NJIT TAB also presented TAB's services and resources available to rural communities in need of technical with their assistance brownfield properties, as well as case studies of communities using TAB assistance in the New England area.

The goal of the event was to serve as an educational forum for the citizens of Fitzwilliam to understand the brownfield process and be updated on the status of the Meadowood brownfield site. Other topics discussed at the event included:

- NHDES Voluntary Cleanup Program
- NH Brownfield Liability Issues
- NH Brownfield Success Stories

Approximately, 20 people attended. The audience primarily consisted of concerned citizens and town selectmen.
