2019 West Virginia Brownfields Grant Writing Boot Camp

At the request of the West Virginia Brownfields Assistance Center, NJIT TAB served as an expert speaker alongside WVDEP, and USEPA Region 3 for the FY 2020 Grant Writing Boot Camp. The purpose of the boot camp was to assist communities in applying for an EPA brownfield grant application in FY 2020 and to provide tips and tricks to addressing the application guidelines.

Participants were also provided with technical assistance in creating and maintaining all federal government account registrations relevant to the brownfield grant application process.

The boot camp was held on September 10, 2019 in Morgantown, West Virginia. NJIT TAB delivered a grant writing presentation that explained the four main sections of the Assessment and Cleanup grant guidelines. TAB's services and resources available to communities in need of technical assistance with their brownfield properties.

In addition, NJIT TAB presented case studies of communities receiving assessment grants using TAB assistance.

Approximately, 40 people were in attendance. The audience consisted of municipal officials, state representatives, and non-profits.
