NJIT TAB & Partners Conduct Brownfields Forum to Promote Brownfields Interest in the Greater Washington D.C. Area

NJIT TAB, alongside the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments (MWCOG), Maryland Department of Planning (MDP), Maryland Department of Environment (MDE), Virginia Department of Environmental Quality (VADEQ), EPA Region 3 and Washington D.C. Department of Energy and Environment (DOEE) conducted a virtual workshop entitled “Brownfield Development & Your Community” on November 17, 2020.

The virtual workshop served to introduce brownfield redevelopment to local governments and non-profits, and demystify the brownfield redevelopment process and the EPA brownfield grant process.

NJIT TAB and workshop partners also covered the following topics:

- Targeted Brownfield Assessments
- Brownfield redevelopment impact and benefits for the community
- Brownfield assessment, remediation, and redevelopment processes
- Funding sources
- Examples of brownfields that have been successfully redeveloped
- Examples of TAB assistance in the region

NJIT TAB hosted and facilitated the virtual workshop, developed the agenda, and served as an expert speaker. Approximately 40 participants joined the virtual workshop. The audience consisted of members of the MWCOG from Virginia, Washington D.C., and Maryland.
