Green Remediation for the 21st Century

NJIT TAB served as the session lead and coordinated an expert panel for a seminar entitled "Green Remediation for the 21st Century". The panelists for the seminar were William Ponticello from Penn E&R and Katrina VanDeusen from Whitman. The event was held at the Pennsylvania Brownfield Conference in State College, PA on March 11, 2020.

The objective of this seminar was to provide information about minimally invasive "green" technologies that allow for innovative solutions that not only remediate and eliminate contaminants but allow redevelopment to be feasible on brownfield properties.

In addition, the topics discussed at the meeting were:

- In-Situ bioremediation case studies and applications,
- Phytoremediation case studies and applications,
- Cost savings and benefits of green remediation and:
- Departmental regulations of green remediation techniques.

Approximately 50 people were in attendance with an audience consisting of municipal officials, consultants, state environmental professionals, and students.
