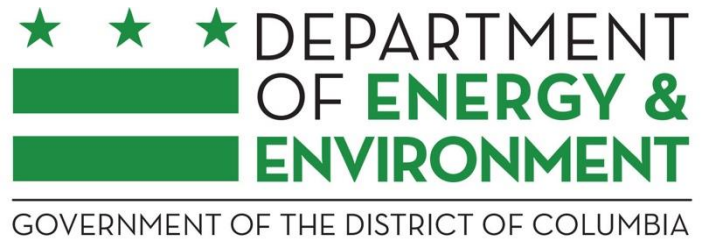

“NJIT TAB conducts Brownfield 101 for Communities in Washington D.C.”



NJIT TAB, alongside EPA Region 3 and Washington D.C. Department of Energy and Environment (DOEE) conducted a “Brownfield 101” virtual workshop on September 21, 2020.

The “Brownfields 101” virtual workshop served to: introduce Brownfield redevelopment to D.C. government and non-profits, demystify the brownfield redevelopment process and the EPA brownfield grant process, and provide tips for preparing EPA Brownfield Grant proposals.

NJIT TAB and partners at the workshop also covered the following topics:

- Targeted Brownfield Assessments
- Brownfield redevelopment impact and benefits for the community
- Brownfield assessment, remediation, and redevelopment processes
- Examples of brownfields that have been successfully redeveloped

NJIT TAB hosted and facilitated the virtual workshop, developed the agenda, and served as an expert speaker. The workshop participants consisted of municipal officials, non-profits, and developers.

The virtual workshop served as the beginning of an ongoing partnership between the new leaders of DOEE and NJIT TAB to educate and engage communities interested in brownfield redevelopment within the D.C. area.
